I. General Information

Art. 1

The European Fistball Association (EFA) acknowledges merit to the European fist ball sport by honors.

It awards

- 1. EFA golden badge of honor
- 2. EFA honorary membership

The following guidelines apply when awarding these honors:

II. Badge of Honor

Art. 2

The golden badge of honor is awarded to the following persons

- EFA board members
- Members of superordinate and friendly organizations
- Special individuals surrounding the European fist ball sport
- Sports and political individuals surrounding the European fist ball sport

The board members of the EFA and the member associations are eligible.

EFA board members are eligible for the award.

III. Honorary Membership

Art. 3

Honorary membership, as the highest honor of the EFA, is awarded to persons who particularly contributed to the guidance of the European federation through creative work within the technical development of the fist ball sport on a world-wide scale or by outstanding promotion of the federation and its work.

Exceptional services are required for this honor.

Art. 4

Honorary membership can also be awarded to personalities from outside of the EFA. Likewise, outstanding services around the fist ball sport on a world-wide scale is a prerequisite.

Art. 5

Honorary membership is awarded without a voice in Congress and in the Board.



Art. 6

The award of honorary membership, which can also take place with the designated honorary president, is confirmed by a certificate and is made official with a personal gift.

Art. 7

The member federations and the board members of the EFA are eligible.

Honor applications are to be submitted at the latest three months before the committee honor date of the EFA.

Art. 8

The EFA congress is eligible for the award. The aim is as unanimous a resolution as possible.

Honor applications are to be justified in detail.

V. Ratification

Art. 10

This Honor Order was ratified by the EFA Committee on 6th February 2016 and come into force on 1st March 2016.
